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**CHALLENGE TO QUALIFICATIONS OF SANDY SENN TO RUN
FOR STATE SENATE IN DISTRICT 41**


Pursuant to S.C. Code § 2-1-40 (3) et seq., Margaret D. Fabri, a resident of District 41, challenges the qualifications of Sandy Senn to register to run for the office of State Senator for District 41.

The basis of Ms. Fabri's challenge is that on information and belief, Ms. Senn is not a resident of District 41 and was not a resident of District 41 at the time of her filing for the Senate seat for District 41. Therefore, pursuant to State statute, Ms. Senn is not eligible to run for the State Senate seat for District 41. Ms. Senn's residence and domicile is listed on the tax records of Charleston County as 290 Little Oak Drive, Folly Beach, South Carolina which is not located in District 41. At this address, Ms. Senn receives the tax rate on her property of 4% which is the tax rate provided to Charleston County owners at their primary residence. If this was not the primary residence and domicile of Ms. Senn, her tax rate would be 6%, which it is not.

Although, prior to Ms. Senn filing for the Senate seat for District 41, she rented a townhouse in District 41, this is not her primary residence nor domicile, therefore, it is clear Ms. Senn has only leased a townhome or condo in District 41 to attempt to circumvent the residency requirements of S.C. Code § 2-1-40, et seq.

I am requesting a hearing on this challenge to Ms. Senn's qualifications to run as a candidate in District 41 as soon as possible but no later than ten (10) days from the date of this challenge pursuant to S.C. Code § 7-5-230 (Cum. Supp. 2015)
